## BOX CHECKED IS THE WARRANTY THAT APPLIES TO THE INSTALLATION BELOW

**RESIDENTIAL APPLICATIONS** - LLUMAR® Magnum Safety and Security Film is warranted against crazing, peeling, discoloration, demetalizing and delaminating by the manufacturer for as long as the original consumer owns and lives in the home when properly installed on suitable interior surfaces of glass windows by a duly authorized dealer. This includes labor and material on safety/security films less than 7 mil thickness. **Films 7 mil and greater require the dealer to be approved by the manufacturer prior to installation to get a film and labor warranty. Unapproved applications are warranted for material replacement only (no labor).**

**COMMERCIAL APPLICATIONS** - LLUMAR® Magnum Safety and Security Film is warranted against crazing, peeling, discoloration, demetalizing and delaminating by the manufacturer for a period of ten (10) years from the date of original purchase when properly installed on suitable interior surfaces of glass windows by a duly authorized dealer. This includes labor and material on safety/security films less than 7 mil thickness. **Films 7 mil and greater require the dealer to be approved by the manufacturer prior to installation to get a film and labor warranty. Unapproved applications are warranted for material replacement only (no labor).**

**2 YEAR THERMAL GLASS BREAKAGE AND SEAL FAILURE FROM DATE OF INSTALLATION FOR: SCL SR PS4, SCL SR PS6, SCL SR PS7, SCL SR PS8, SCL SR PS11, SCL SR PS15, N1040 SR PS4, N1040 SR PS8, N1050 SR PS4, N1050 SR PS8, R 20 SR PS4, R 20 SR PS8, NUV 65 SR PS4 ONLY**

- MUST HAVE EXISTING SEAL FAILURE WARRANTY ON WINDOW
- DUE TO A WIDE VARIETY OF COMPOUNDS USED, NO WARRANTY COVERAGE IS PROVIDED FOR WINDOW "BACKBEDDING SEALANTS".
- NO SEAL FAILURE AND/OR GLASS BREAKAGE COVERAGE ON LAMINATED GLASS, EXCEPT AS NOTED ON CPFILMS FILM TO GLASS RECOMMENDATIONS
- INSTALLATIONS OVER 2500 SQUARE FEET REQUIRE PRE-APPROVAL FROM CPFILMS
- MAXIMUM ALLOWANCE IS U.S. \$500 PER GLASS
- GLASS BREAKAGE AND/OR SEAL FAILURE MUST BE A RESULT OF LLUMAR PRODUCT LISTED ABOVE
- THERE IS A DEDUCTIBLE OF \$25.00 (U.S. \$) OR 5% OF THE REPLACEMENT COST, WHICHEVER IS GREATER, FOR RESIDENTIAL AND SMALL COMMERCIAL INSTALLATIONS. THE DEDUCTIBLE FOR COMMERCIAL INSTALLATIONS AND INSTALLATIONS OVER 2,500 SQ. FT. IS \$100.00 (U.S. \$) OR 5% OF THE REPLACEMENT COST, WHICHEVER IS GREATER.

If the film fails to comply under recommended use within the warranty period, the film will be replaced (Labor and Materials) at no cost to the consumer by the manufacturer. CPFilms reserves the right to inspect any film failures. In order to obtain replacement of the film, the information contained in the installation record or bill of sale furnished at the time of purchase, which includes evidence that the film is LLumar® Magnum, together with a description of the specific defect should be sent to the authorized dealer from which the film was originally purchased or to CPFilms, Warranty Services, Post Office Box 5068, Martinsville, VA 24115. Proof of purchase is also required in order to obtain warranty coverage. It is therefore recommended that the purchaser retain the completed installation record or sales receipt and original copy of this warranty.

CPFilms' sole obligation to the owner/purchaser, whether claim be based in contract, negligence, tort or otherwise, shall be solely as provided hereunder and damages and remedies shall be as provided hereunder.

CPFilms HEREBY DISCLAIMS LIABILITY FOR ANY INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES ARISING FROM ANY DEFECT IN THE PRODUCT COVERED BY THIS WARRANTY. EXCEPT DURING THE APPLICABLE LIMITED WARRANTY PERIOD SET FORTH ABOVE, CPFilms, HEREBY EXCLUDES AND DISCLAIMS ANY AND ALL OTHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING THE WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

The manufacturer assumes no liability for glass breakage or seal failure from any cause unless the 2 year thermal glass breakage and seal failure box is marked above. **IF YOU DESIRE GLASS BREAKAGE AND/OR SEAL FAILURE WARRANTY COVERAGE FOR ANY PRODUCTS OTHER THAN THOSE LISTED ABOVE WITH THE 2 YEAR THERMAL GLASS BREAKAGE AND SEAL FAILURE, IT MUST BE PURCHASED SEPARATELY AND REQUIRES A RECEIPT FROM CPFilms TO BE VALID.**

**This limited warranty applies only to LLumar® Magnum Safety and Security Film with product prefix letters SCL, R (except R30BSRPS4 and R30GSRPS4), and N, when installed in the United States and Canada.**

# CPFilms LIMITED GLASS AND SEAL FAILURE WARRANTY

The manufacturer warrants against failure of the glass described herein due to

- Seal Failure for a period of twenty four (24) months if covered by original seal unit manufacturer (excluding laminated glass, except as noted on CPFilms Film to Glass Recommendations).
- Thermal Shock Fracture for a period of twenty four (24) months (excluding laminated glass, except as noted on CPFilms Film to Glass Recommendations)

from the original completion date of the film installation to the glass. The replacement cost is limited to a value up to U.S. \$500 per window of said glass caused only as a direct result of the application of the LLumar® Magnum Solar Control Window Film.

In the event of glass breakage or seal failure due to thermal shock caused solely as the direct result of the application of an approved CPFilms' film, the manufacturer will:

1. Replace the broken glass and/or repair or replace the sealed insulating unit.
2. Replace and/or repair the portion of the window frame in direct contact with the glass, if it is damaged due to breakage or seal failure (excluding painting or finishing).
3. Replace the window film.

### Window Care:

- To ensure long life and maximum serviceability from LLUMAR Window Film, **DO NOT WASH FOR THIRTY (30) DAYS AFTER INSTALLATION.**
- When Cleaning use a soft cloth or clean synthetic sponge. Use a soft cloth or squeegee for drying the window. Use common cleaning solutions which do not contain abrasive materials.
- After installation, there may be a hazy appearance. This condition is temporary, caused by the moisture used in applying the film. After this moisture dries, the hazy condition will disappear.

The following terms and conditions apply:

1. We will pay for repairs or replacement of up to (but not to exceed) \$500 (U.S. \$) per glazing unit.
2. **There is a deductible of \$25.00 (U.S. \$) or 5% of the replacement cost, whichever is greater, for residential and small commercial installations. The deductible for commercial installation over 2,500 sq. ft. is \$100.00 (U.S. \$) or 5% of the replacement cost, whichever is greater.**
3. The warranty coverage is limited to the owner of the property at the time of installation.
4. CPFilms as the window film manufacturer will not be liable under any circumstances for any damages occurring as a direct or indirect result of causes not specifically covered or for any indirect, incidental or consequential damages.
5. Pre-existing conditions of either glass breakage or seal failure of the filmed lite voids this warranty coverage. CPFilms reserves the right to inspect any job prior to final issuance of a certificate of warranty coverage. Fraud by the installing dealer or warrantee shall void the warranty.
6. **In order to qualify for seal failure coverage, the owner must present evidence that a seal failure warranty is currently in force from the manufacturer of the sealed glass unit. This warranty for seal failure will not extend beyond the sealed unit's manufacturer's limited warranty.**
7. The warranty shall be completely invalidated if any information or representation set forth on the front of this form is not accurate.
8. CPFilms reserves the right to reapply window film after two (2) occurrences to the same lite and will refund the consumer's money for the original filming of said lite.
9. **CPFilms, HEREBY DISCLAIMS LIABILITY FOR ANY INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES ARISING FROM ANY DEFECT IN THE PRODUCT COVERED BY THIS WARRANTY. EXCEPT DURING THE APPLICABLE LIMITED WARRANTY PERIOD SET FORTH ABOVE, CPFilms, HEREBY EXCLUDES AND DISCLAIMS ANY AND ALL OTHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING THE WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.**

This warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights which vary from State/Province to State/Province.
10. "Thermal shock fracture" means a breaking or fracture to glass caused by heat or change in temperature resulting from the application of film to glass, and thermal shock breakage can be identified by the following characteristics, (a) break lines make a right angle with the edge of glass at or near the origin, and (b) break lines separate into two (2) or more lines within two (2) inches of the edge and the origin. Tempered glass is not susceptible to thermal shock generated by solar control film.
11. Seal failure is defined as a visible break or opening of the window's air seal, resulting in an ineffective sealing of the window, allowing moisture and/or air to penetrate, causing an internal fogging of the glass.
12. This limited warranty shall NOT apply to applications in the following installations: (a) when not in strict compliance with current rules and regulations promulgated by the manufacturer; or (b) of more than one (1) film to any window; or (c) on triple pane windows, wired or textured glass, any glass on which there is affixed or otherwise applied any paint, lettering or ornamentation; or (d) on glass which is visibly damaged, chipped, cracked or pierced or where light can be seen between glass and frame; or (e) on nonglass materials, such as polycarbonates or other plastics; or (f) in locations in which there has been prior glass breakage; or (g) on glass which is framed by concrete, solid metal or sealant which is no longer resilient; or (h) on any glass of 100 square feet or more or having any linear dimension of more than 12 feet; or (i) when damage occurs partly by reason of loss by any cause other than thermal shock fracture, including, but not limited to, impact, stress, scratching, improper application or installation, wind or the elements, earthquakes or other acts of God, fire, war, invasion, hostilities, rebellion, insurrection, wear and tear, inherent vice, pre-existing break, or latent defect; or (j) when 25% or less of a glass lite is shaded and the shaded area includes more than 25% of the lite's perimeter. A portion of the examples of such harmful shading is as follows:
